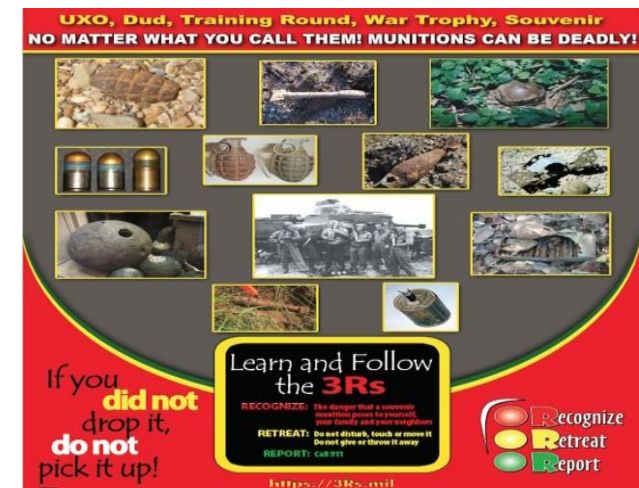
Unexploded Ordnance

3Rs (Recognize, Retreat, Report) Explosives Safety Program (3Rs Program)

Developed to educate Soldiers, Family members, Civilians, Contractors and communities about the potential hazards of military ammunition / explosives and what to do if they are encountered.

- Tinnitus (ringing in the ears) management services are available but require a consult from their Primary Care Manager.

✓ **Beneficiaries**

- TRICARE East/Humana covers diagnostic evaluations and hearing aids but a referral from your Primary Care Manager is required.

✓ **Retirees**

- Diagnostic evaluations and hearing aid services are available through their local VA Audiology clinic.
