



• Why: February through June has seen increased risk for suicide in previous years. This event provides an opportunity to address known risk factors.

• How: Start each morning with a 4.4 mile snowshoe hike through Remington Pond. Before or after each hike, we will have a different class each day. Topics will address physical health, and resilience factors:

26 Feb - Basic Snowshoeing prior to event

27 Feb - Resilience (Stress Management)

28 Feb - Spiritual Health

29 Feb - Proper Nutrition for long training events

1 Mar - Healthy Sleep




