- ❖ TA has increased to \$4500 per Army FY.

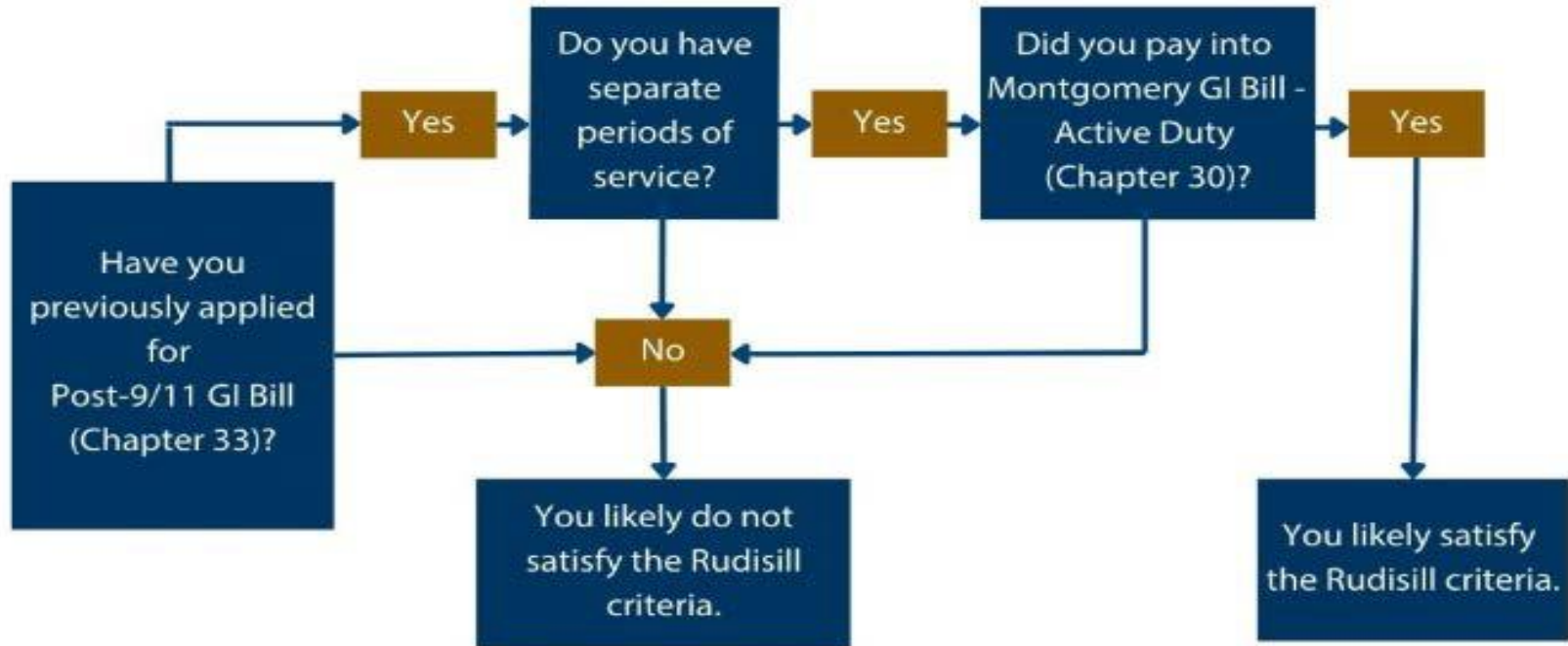
