

#### **AFAP ISSUES**



### **FAMILY AND MORALE, WELFARE AND RECREATION - GYMS**

**Issue 1** – Need 24 hour gyms, larger gyms, pools never open when people can use them.

**Scope:** Waiting in line to workout, gyms too crowded, pool not available **Recommendation:** Adjust the hours of operation and expand facility operating hours.

**Issue 2 -** Not enough functional fitness/crossfit facilities, too crowded, hours of operation (6 submissions)

**Scope:** Soldier readiness, only crossfit facility available, too crowded, can't support classes and coaching.

**Recommendation:** Add more staff and equipment to the facility, another facility





#### **FAMILY AND MORALE, WELFARE AND RECREATION - CYS**

**Issue 3 -** CYS Registration Process

**Scope:** Parents must re-register and redo large amounts of paperwork for Child and Youth Services (CYS) when they move from one installation to another or when they re-register their child each year.

**Recommendation:** (1) CYS registration information should transfer from post-to-post. (2) Sports physicals should not need to be updated with each move (and should transfer). (3) There should be an Army-wide online system for CYS information versus by installation.

**Issue 4 -** Waitlist for childcare too long and qualified/safe childcare for evening hours

**Scope:** Spouses do not have safe childcare for evening hours. Child care waiting lists are too long.

**Recommendation:** Sponsored evening care.





### **DIRECTORATE OF PUBLIC WORKS**

**Issue 5 -** Mud and gravel around the buildings (CPAC) on South Post.

**Scope:** Hinders access for people in general and those with disabilities, tracks gravel and mud into facilities.

**Recommendation:** Pave the driveways and areas around and up to the doors

**Issue 6 -** Running trails are falling apart

**Scope:** Makes it hard to share trails with the other units

**Recommendation:** Refurbish the trails

**Issue 7 - Traffic Lights, Road Conditions** 

**Scope:** Traffic lights are taking to long to change and the roads are full of pot holes

**Recommendation:** The traffic lights should be re-timed and fixing of the roads should be done





#### **DIRECTOR OF EMERGENCY SERVICES**

**Issue 8 -** Black River Gate (5 submissions)

**Scope:** Working on South post has very limited access when entering. It also takes extra time when going to South Post and at the lunch hour, time is limited. All is geared towards new post; access, places to eat, etc.

Recommendation: Limited hours of access in am and pm.

#### **FINANCE**

**Issue 9 -** Military Pay Issues (5 submissions), BAS not processed quickly, paperwork to stop meal deductions not processed.

Scope: Can't afford to pay bills, keep taking funds from Soldier pay.

**Recommendation:** Finance needs to address and fix situation





### **COMMISSARY**

Issue 10 - Lack of Seafood to choose from and Produce is not good

**Scope:** Soldiers and Families should be provided a variety of choices in the store, such as seafood. The produce provided is not good quality.

**Recommendation:** Provide a seafood department and purchase produce from a different source

**Issue 11 - Commissary closed on Monday** 

Scope: Submitter thought that Monday was not a good day to be closed

**Recommendation:** Choose another day of the week





#### **MOUNTAIN COMMUNITY HOMES**

**Issue 12 - Reduction of Monthly Lease Payments** 

**Scope**: Request assistance in lowering the monthly lease payments for housing

**Recommendation:** Research and consider in providing assistance or lowering lease payments

**Issue 13 –** Stray dogs, barking, roaming, aggressive dogs

**Scope:** Dogs run loose in the neighborhoods, barking dogs.

**Recommendation:** 24 hour animal control





#### THE EXCHANGE

Issue 14 - PX needs WiFi

Scope: There is no Wi-Fi at the Post exchange

Recommendation: Install Wi-Fi

Issue 15 - More 24 hour stores and choices to eat

**Scope:** Currently there is one 24 hour store on post, need more especially on South Post. The selection of eateries not the greatest

**Recommendation:** Add more 24 hour stores and selections of eateries.





#### **MEDDAC**

**Issue 16 -** Open Referral – EFMP delay in orders because of open referrals

**Scope:** Submitter would like to PCS to a new duty station but is unable to do so because of an EFMP Open Referral

**Recommendation:** Allow people to update their EFMP regardless of an open referral or whatever the case maybe, one can research if to find out if next duty station can provide needed treatment if necessary.

**Issue 17 - Health care for Soldiers** 

**Scope:** Health care for Soldiers – wait time to see providers for serious health issues

**Recommendation**: Providers should be brought on, waiting for 30 days to see a specialist does not seem appropriate





Issue 18 - Information disseminated to spouses/spouse in-processing

**Scope:** Spouses need information. After the FRSA went away we rushed the transition and the FRG is not as strong as it could be.

**Recommendation:** Implement a Spouse Sponsorship Program to highlight events, trainings and knowledge new spouses need to link them to "Mountain veteran spouses."
