

The Voucher System

- ✓ Volunteers obtain a signed voucher from the organization at the end of their volunteer time each shift they volunteer
- ✓ If using Chapel Drive CDC Hourly Care, volunteers submit completed/signed vouchers to Memorial when picking up child(ren). Volunteers are not responsible for payment for volunteer time
- ✓ If using off-post Preschool/Home Child Care, volunteers submit completed/signed vouchers to care provider for their signature. Volunteers then submit the completed voucher back to the organization. A check will be sent directly to the volunteer.

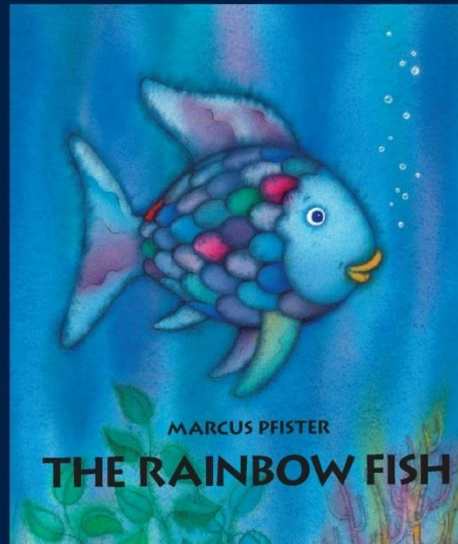
The Caveats!

- VSF will reimburse up to \$150 per month per volunteer
- VSF will reimburse up to \$4 per hour per child (current CYSS rate)
- Volunteers must be approved/registered on VMIS
- 15 minute travel time to and from (total of 30 minutes) automatically added to shift
- Home Care givers must be at least 13 years old and not a member of volunteer's immediate family
- Vouchers must be submitted to VSF before the end of the month
