PROJECT GOALS


 Develop an overall transit evaluation criteria for each regional transportation corridor.

 Prepare a preliminary visual representation of transit for each corridor.


 Develop a corridor screening, ranking, and selection process to recommend corridors that will benefit from the implementation of a new transit system.

 Analyze financial feasibility for operating costs associated with providing the transit service


PROJECT STUDY AREA AND DESTINATIONS




HOUSING AND WORK LOCATION




TRANSIT MARKET STRENGTH
