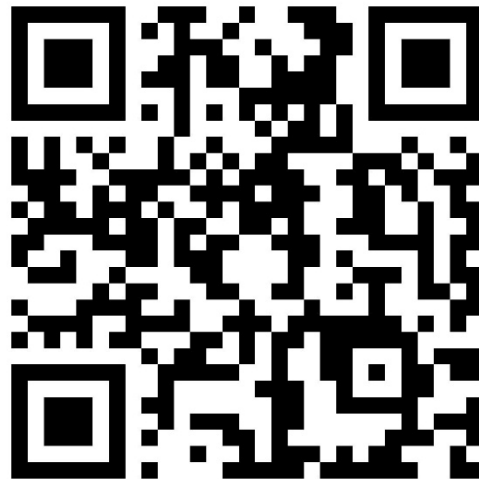

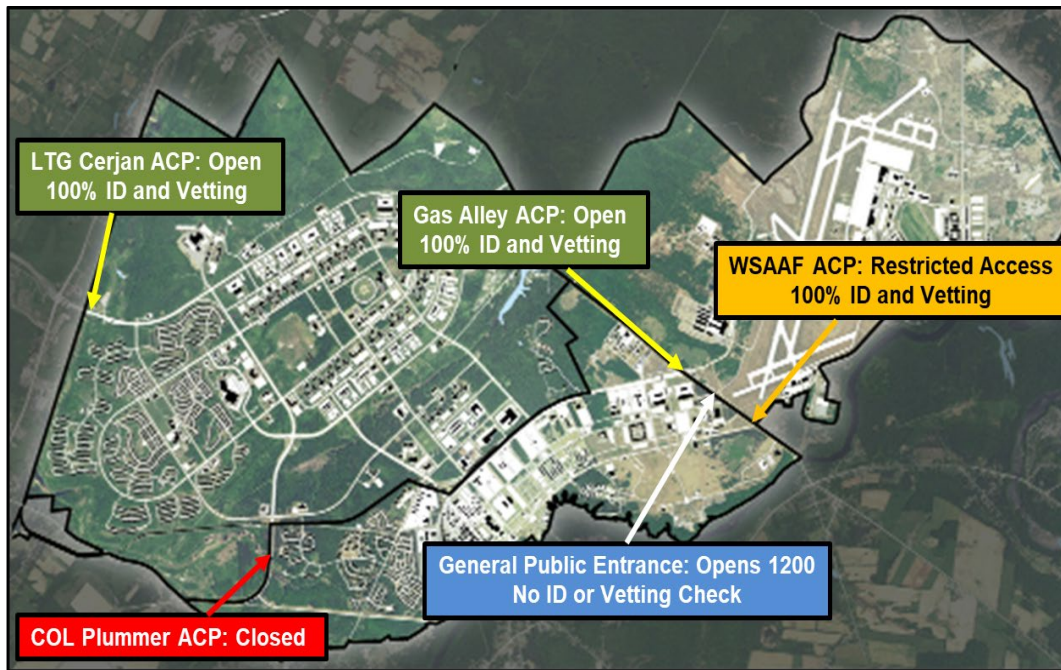

Acceptable Documents to Real Identification

Compliance with the REAL ID Act of 2005 effective 07MAY2025

Star, Flag or Not for Federal Purposes on the ID Visitors requesting access with no REAL ID or compliant supplementary form of identification must be sponsored and always escorted while on the installation. Personnel requiring escort will not be authorized Local Access Badge (LAB) credentials

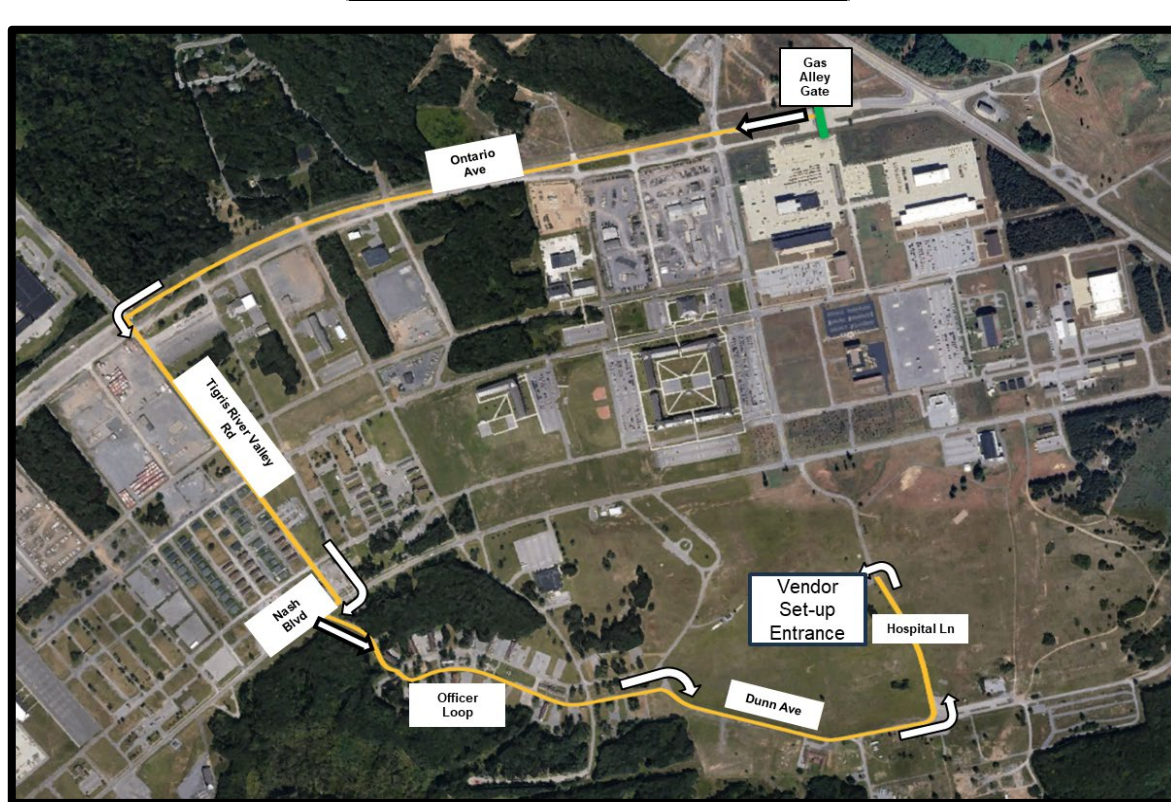

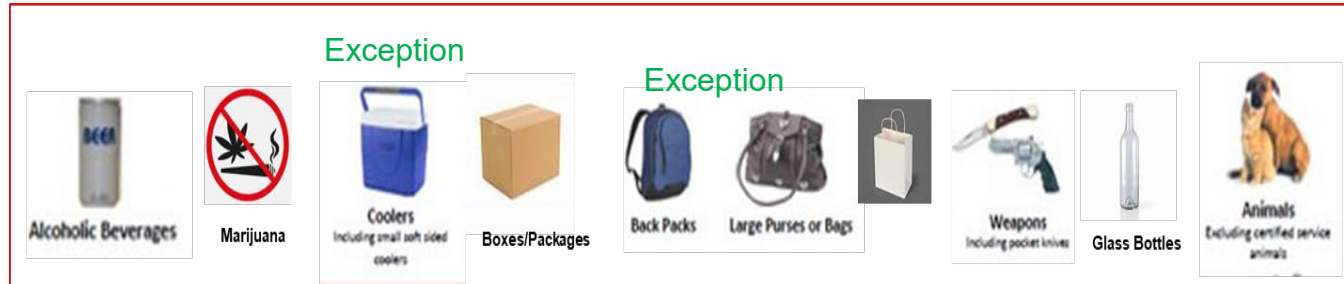

What is Tricare Prime?

TRICARE is the uniformed services' health care program, with a worldwide network of military hospitals, clinics, and civilian health care providers

TRICARE Prime is a managed care option for active-duty service members (ADSMs) and their families, retired service members and their families (aside from those eligible for Medicare based on age), and other beneficiary categories (see website for details)

- ADSMs **MUST** enroll in TRICARE Prime
- Beneficiaries receive most care from their assigned PCM at the MTF
- PCMs refer beneficiaries to specialists for care as needed
- ADSMs pay nothing out-of-pocket

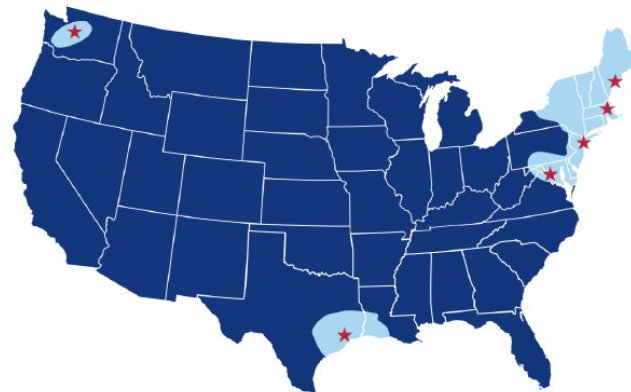


What is the USFHP?

The **USFHP (Martin's Point)** is a TRICARE Prime option available through networks of community-based, not-for-profit health care systems in six areas of the United States open to active-duty family members, retired service members and their families, and other beneficiary categories (see website for details).

- Active-Duty Service Members **CANNOT** enroll in Martin's Point
- Expect **CO-PAYS** at appointments and for medications
- All care is provided by a designated USFHP primary care physician or specialist
- Beneficiaries **CANNOT** access any medical care on Fort Drum, to include pharmacy, laboratory, or radiology



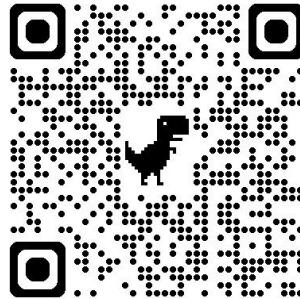

What qualifies as a family emergency?

Death, serious hospitalization, birth of a child, etc.


How does the process work?

1. The Red Cross Hero Care Network is contacted.
2. The Red Cross verifies the emergency to be factual.
3. The message is delivered to the service member's command so that they can make an informed decision regarding emergency leave.
4. The service member is notified by command regarding the leave decision.

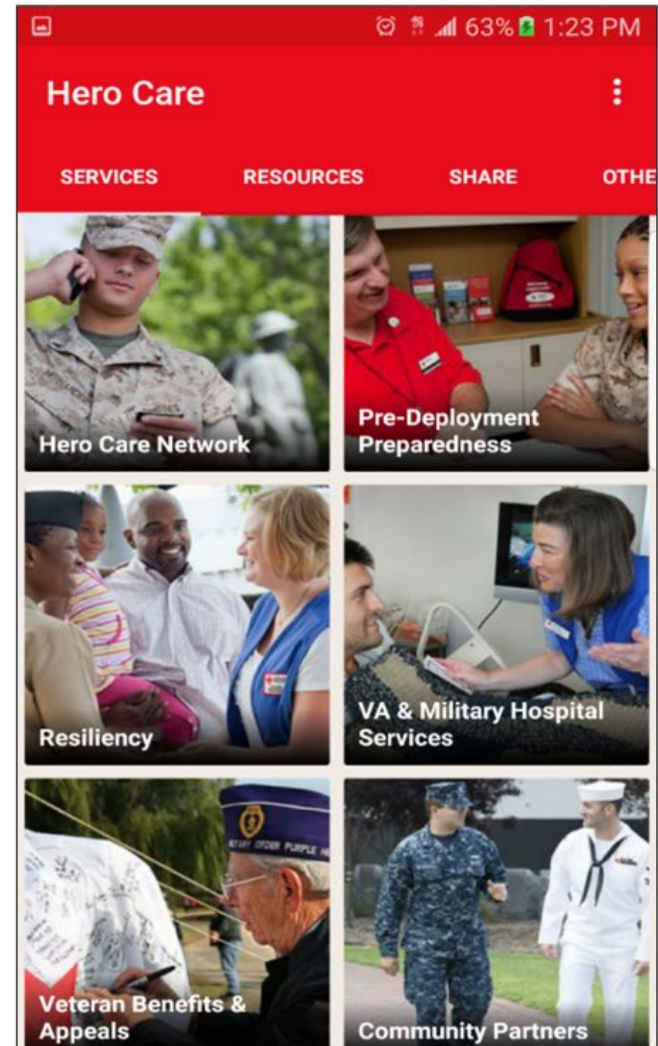
