

HELP ADVISORY
PROGRAM



- (1) **UNIT TAX ADVISORS (UTAs)** ARE AVAILABLE IN EVERY BRIGADE AND BATTALION TO ASSIST SOLDIERS WITH THEIR RETURNS. Your unit has an IRStrained and certified Officer or NCO ready to offer guidance and help with preparing your income tax return using the tax return program of your choice. To find out who your UTA is, check with your Staff Duty Desk, S3, and chain of command, or call the Legal Assistance Office at 315-772-5261.
- (2) **FACILITATED KIOSKS** ARE AVAILABLE IN THE LEGAL ASSISTANCE OFFICE FOR YOU AND YOUR UNIT TAX ADVISOR TO USE TAXSLAYER. Kiosk appointments are available in 1 hour increments. Soldiers are asked to set up appointments through their Unit Tax Advisor. Retirees can set up appointments through the Legal Assistance Office directly by calling (315) 772-5261.
- (3) **TAX PREP CLASS** TAKES PLACE EVERY TUESDAY AT 1:00 PM AND 6:00 PM IN ROOM C1-34 IN CLARK HALL. The class will be about 2 hours and is aimed towards reducing your fear of doing your own returns and giving you a life skill that will eliminate your future dependency on third party tax preparers. The class is designed for people who have never done their own income taxes, who are new to the military, and who may have done their own taxes in the past but would benefit from refresher training. All DOD-ID cardholders are welcome to attend. No appointments necessary.
- (4) **LEGAL ASSISTANCE** ATTORNEYS ARE AVAILABLE TO HELP PREPARE RETURNS FOR GOLD STAR FAMILIES, TO ASSIST DEPLOYED SPOUSES AND RETIREES WITH THE PREPARATION OF THEIR RETURNS, TO PROVIDE LEGAL TAX ADVICE, AND TO HELP WITH MORE COMPLICATED TAX QUESTIONS from all persons eligible for Legal Assistance Services under Army Regulation 27-3. Active Duty Soldiers must first contact their Unit Tax Advisor before calling Legal Assistance. Spouses and retirees can set up appointments through the Legal Assistance Office by calling (315) 772-5261.

#### **EXCLUSIONS**

Please note that income tax assistance is not available for any private business activities, except FCC providers. Private business activities are outside the scope of the program. Ownership of multiple rental homes is considered a private business activity. Assistance is also not available for more than 10 stock transactions.

Volunteers may use CYSS programs, off-post programs, or <u>approved</u> home care. Home care restrictions apply.

Volunteers may not request reimbursement of any month more than one month prior to the current month submitted.

Retroactive requests will be denied.


