VSF will reimburse up to \$150 cumulative per month per Volunteer.

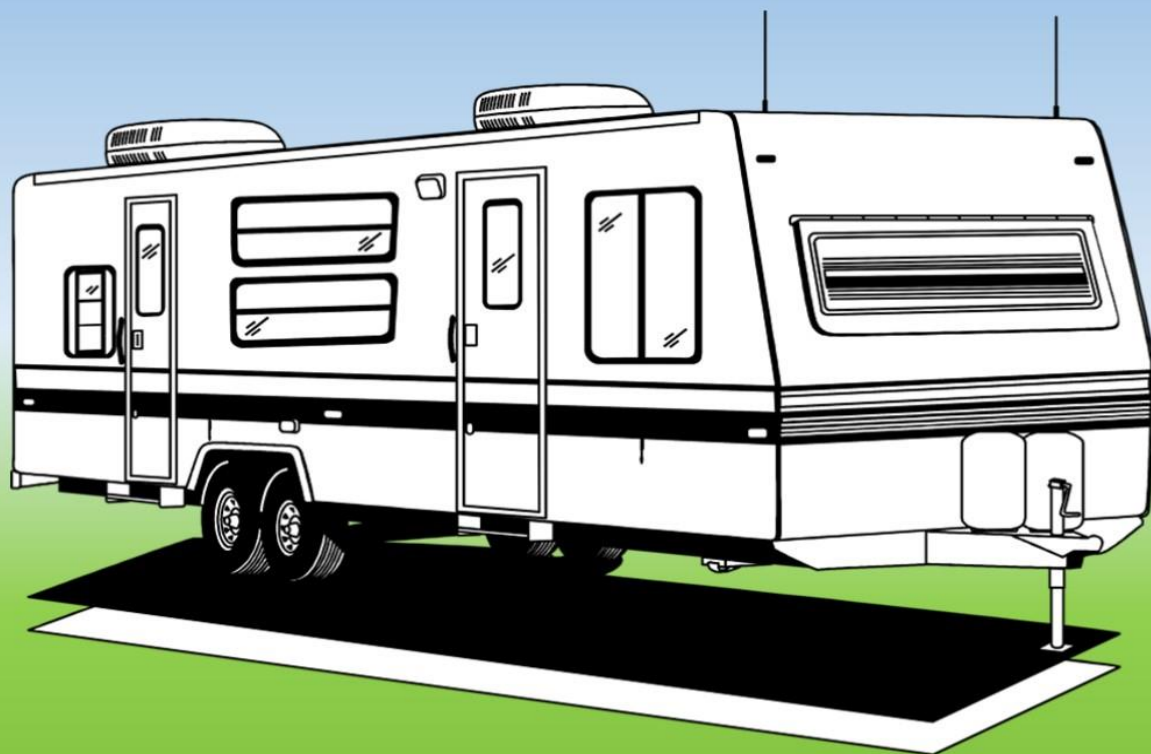
VSF will reimburse a Volunteer's **Actual** hourly rate **up to** the current CYSS hourly rate (\$4.00). This amount is coordinated directly between VSF and CYSS for accuracy.

Volunteers may use CYSS programs, off-post programs, or approved home care. Home care restrictions apply.

Volunteers may not request reimbursement of any month more than one month prior to the current month submitted. Retroactive requests will be denied.

Domestic Abuse: Two Reporting Options

Unrestricted Reporting

Command & Law Enforcement Involved

- Launches official investigation
- Access command support, medical treatment, victim advocacy, counseling and support
- Incidents will be reported to:
 - Command
 - Law Enforcement Officer
 - Family Advocacy Program

All reports of child abuse are unrestricted and will be investigated.

Restricted Reporting

Preserves Privacy & Limits Who's Involved

- Command and law enforcement not involved
- Maintain privacy; access medical treatment, victim advocacy, counseling and support
- You must report only to:
 - Military health care provider
 - Family Advocacy Program Manager
 - Domestic Abuse Victim Advocate
 - Clinical Treatment Provider

Reporting to others may trigger command or law enforcement involvement.

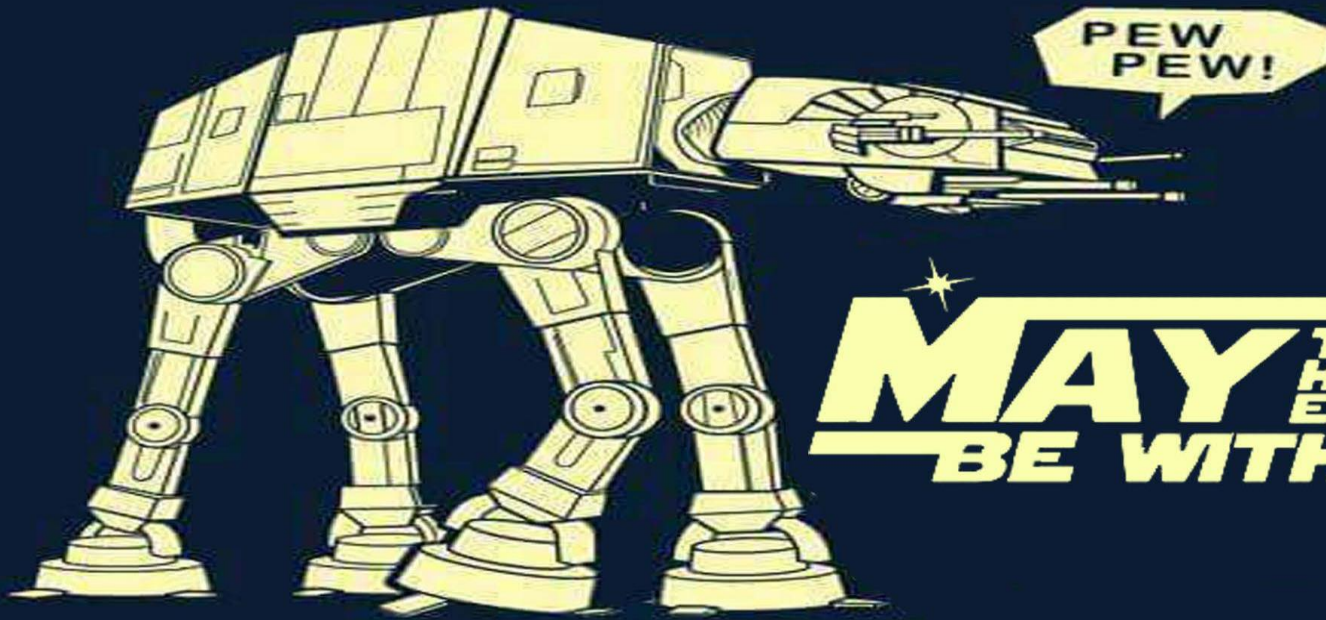

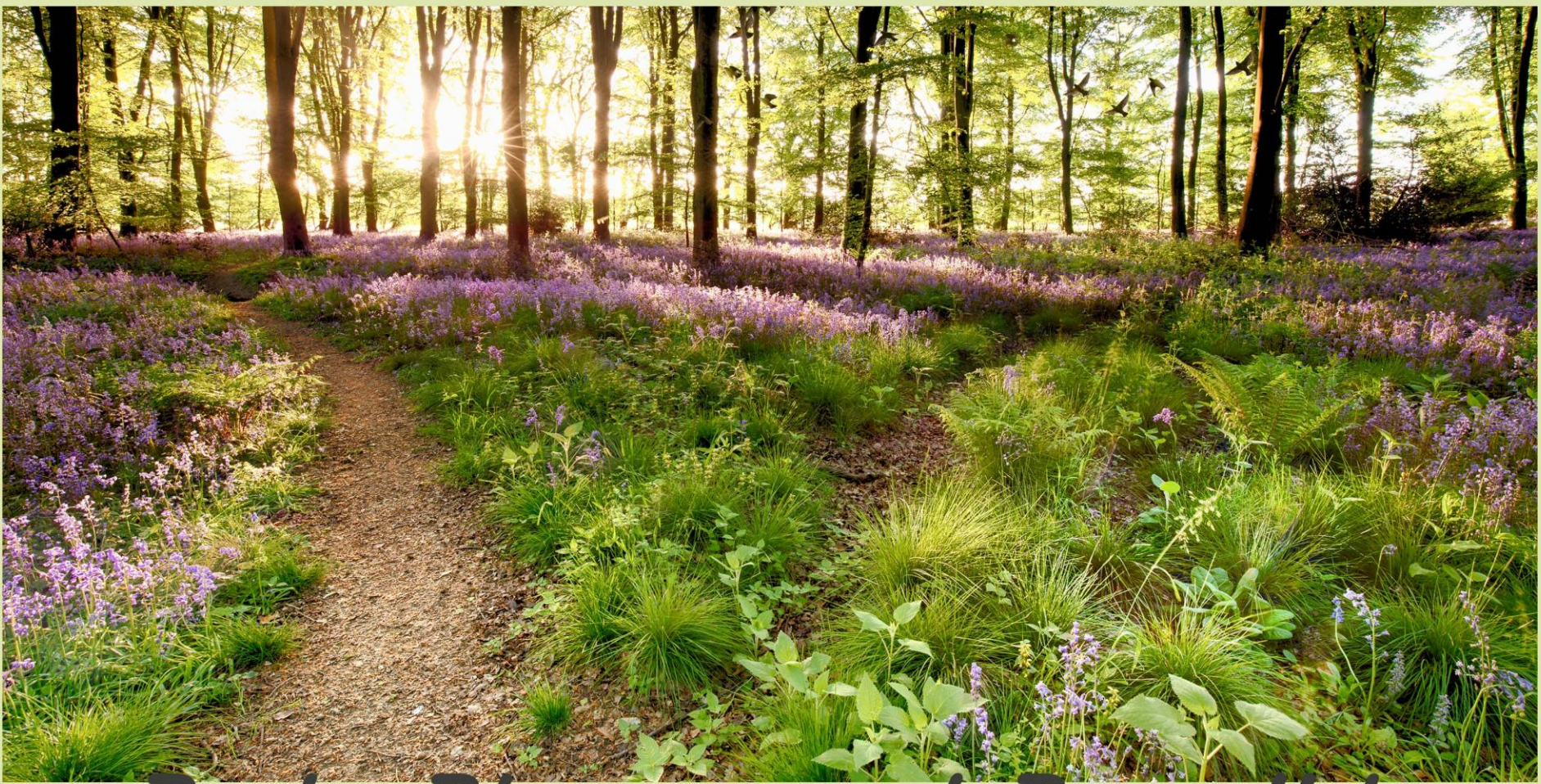
