VSF will reimburse up to \$150 cumulative per month per Volunteer.

VSF will reimburse a Volunteer's <u>Actual</u>
https://doi.org/10.15 the current CYSS hourly rate (\$4.00). This amount is coordinated directly between VSF and CYSS for accuracy.

Volunteers may use CYSS programs, off-post programs, or <u>approved</u> home care. Home care restrictions apply.

Volunteers may not request reimbursement of any month more than one month prior to the current month submitted.

Retroactive requests will be denied.
