#### Military Spouse Preference (MSP)

## Military Spouse Preference (MSP)

- This appointment authority is application based/self-nominating. A spouse can apply and identify his/her preference for any vacancy within USA jobs that identifies MSP as an eligibility.
- For MSP consideration include orders to Fort Drum; marriage certificate; MSP checklist (dated within the past 30 days); other required documents (licensure, transcripts, etc.).
- MSP applicants are considered Best Qualified when their answers to the assessment questionnaire meet or exceed numerical cut-off score set by management prior to recruitment AND they meet the minimum qualifications identified in the vacancy announcement.
- If there are 2 or more qualified MSP applicants, they may be interviewed at management's discretion.





### Military Spouse Preference (MSP)

#### MSP Continued:

Spouse must be within commuting area of sponsor's duty location to be eligible for MSP. Further, spouse cannot claim preference until they are located at that duty station (Fort Drum).

MSP is a one time authority per duty station when offered for a continuing position. Other spouse appointment eligibilities can be used more than once (EO 13473, EO 12721).
