World Rabies Day

World Rabies Day, September 28th

What is Rabies?

Rabies is a fatal but preventable viral disease. Animals most frequently found with rabies are bats, skunks, raccoons, and foxes.

What should I do if an animal bites or scratches me?

Immediately clean the wound with large amounts of water and promptly seek medical attention.

What about the animal?

If possible, secure the animal without sustaining any additional injuries. The animal should be turned over to a veterinarian for evaluation.

What if your pet bites someone or you are bitten?

Your pet will not be removed from you. Your pet must be confined at home for a designated observation period to monitor for rabies.

What if I find a bat in my home?

Call Public Health and seek medical care. Bats have very small teeth; bites may go unnoticed.

FORT DRUM POL and HAZARDOUS WASTE DISPOSAL PROCEDURES AND OTHER COMPLIANCE INFORMATION

REPORT ALL SPILLS TO THE FORT DRUM FIRE DEPARTMENT BY CALLING 911



BATTERIES: Units/Activities must turn in all batteries (**except lead acid and alkaline**) by calling the "You Call – We Haul" service to coordinate pick up at (315) 772-6111. Batteries must be segregated by type. Exposed **battery terminals must be taped** using clear tape to prevent short circuiting. **DO NOT** activate the Complete Discharge Device (CDD) on lithium batteries. **Alkaline** batteries are non-hazardous and should be discarded as trash in brown dumpsters. **Lead acid batteries to include automotive/Hawker/SLA (starter batteries)/VRLA (Valve Regulated Lead-Acid/AGM (Absorbent Glass Mat)/Gel types** from units must be turned into their SSA. SSA is required to palletize lead acid batteries using carboard slip sheets and shrink wrap for disposal/recycling, contact Exide at (315) 806-2529 to schedule for pickup weekly on Wednesday. All other activities with lead acid batteries for disposal/recycling must palletize using cardboard slip sheets and shrink wrap, contact Exide at (315) 806-2529 for pickup weekly on Wednesday.

HAZARDOUS WASTE (HW)¹: Call the "You Call – We Haul" service at (315) 772-6111 for assistance with disposal of hazardous waste such as: paint, fluorescent bulbs, insect repellents, aerosols, etc., and pumping service.

Empty Aerosol Cans: Metal drums with dome lids are provided by the Environmental Division to use for collecting empty aerosol cans. Call "You Call – We Haul" service at (315) 772-6111 to coordinate disposal of empty aerosols or procurement of metal drum. **Unwanted or unserviceable aerosol cans** containing product must be stored in a flammable locker until called in for pickup by "You Call – We Haul."

MRE HEATERS: Flameless Ration Heaters (FRH) should be deactivated by utilizing the enclosed wetting agent before disposal in dumpsters. Otherwise, these heaters can combust and start fires in dumpsters or landfills.

OIL/FUEL FILTERS²: Units with oil filter crushers must "hot drain" them for 24 hours and place them in a scrap metal receptacle for recycling after crushing. Units that do **NOT** have a crusher must place 24 hour hot-drained filters in their POL shed in a container labeled "Used Oil Filters." Full containers must be taken to the Public Works (PW) POL Operations Center, Bldg. T-3829. Filters can be dropped off at this facility between 1300-1500 every Tuesday, or by appointment by calling (315) 772-0367. **Paper-type fuel filters** should be air dried, double bagged, and then placed in dumpsters. **Metal fuel filters** should be air dried and placed in a scrap metal bin.

SOILED RAGS: **Oil/grease (POL)** soaked rags must be turned in at Bldg. P-2018 on Tuesdays from 1300-1500. Soiled rags should be doubled bagged in clear plastic trash bags prior to turn-in. **Chemical-soaked (solvents, paint stripper, etc.)** rags must be turned into hazardous waste. Call "You Call – We Haul" at (315) 772-6111 to coordinate pick up.

MIXING CUPS USED FOR PAINTS AND ADHESIVES: All hazardous used mixing cups/containers will be marked with the complete NSN and manufacturer of the product. Call the "You Call - We Haul" program for turn in, (315) 772-6111.

AIR FRAME PAINTS SHOP TENTS: In addition to mixing cups (see above paragraph) all empty or unwanted containers (paints/adhesives) will be managed as hazardous waste. All used air filters will be bagged and marked identifying the air system and phase and managed as hazardous waste. All hazardous waste will be turned in by calling the "You Call-We Haul" program, (315) 772-6111.

PETROLEUM-CONTAMINATED SOIL, SLUDGE, DRY-SWEEP²: Bring to Bldg. P-2018 on Tuesdays from 1300-1500.

USED ANTIFREEZE, USED OIL & OFF-SPEC FUEL²: To coordinate for pickup/removal, call (315) 772-6111.

STORAGE TANKS²: Most above ground storage tanks (ASTs) are equipped with alarms indicating when full or leaking. If the alarm sounds, **immediately** call (315) 772-0367.

SHOP FLOOR CLEAN-UP OR ENGINE CLEANING: No solvents or soaps will be used to clean shop floors or engines. Steam cleaning is acceptable. For information call (315) 772-4860.

Compliance Assistance Information: Available by calling the Compliance Assist Team at (315) 286-7371, (315) 955-4294 or (315) 523-1241.

REFRIGERANT (FREON): Call (315) 772-2260 for information about refrigerant removal from refrigerators/freezers before disposal. Call to turn in excess/unused/unwanted refrigerant canisters.

COMPRESSED GAS CYLINDERS: Units should turn in to their SSA or call the HMCC for guidance at (315) 772-4783. **THE HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY (11144) DOES NOT ACCEPT COMPRESSED GAS CYLINDERS FOR TURN IN.**

FIRE EXTINGUISHERS: Contact the Fire Inspector at (315) 772-4702. **THE HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY (11144) DOES NOT ACCEPT FIRE EXTINGUISHERS FOR TURN IN.**

GOV OWNED ELECTRONIC WASTE (E-WASTE): Turn-in to the AFSBn, Property Book Office, Bldg. 4525 Camp Hale Road (315) 772-5941. Non-Gov owned E-Waste can be disposed of at the Fort Drum DPW Transfer Site, Bldg. 11001 Iraqi Freedom Dr., for information call (315) 523-0021.

EMPTY METAL DRUMS AND 5 GALLON CANS: Ensure drained/empty and take to the Fort Drum DPW Transfer Site, Bldg. 11001 Iraqi Freedom Dr., for disposal. Call (315) 523-0021 for information.

SINGLE STREAM (BLUE) DUMPSTER: Only empty small metal cans, plastic containers, paper, glass containers and clean cardboard may be disposed of in these. If you have a Cardboard ONLY dumpster, please only deposit clean cardboard in them (meaning only cardboard, no paper or plastic).

PRINTER/TONER CARTRIDGES: If RICOHs then the following link provides their take back program: <https://www.ricoh-usa.com/en/about-us/environment/recycling-programs>. If different manufactures, please use the following link for the non-Ricoh consumables: www.greenimpressionsrecycling.com. **THE HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY (11144) DOES NOT ACCEPT THESE CARTRIDGES FOR TURN IN.**

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS MUST BE RECYCLED: Cardboard, junk mail, magazines, newspaper, office paper, glass jars and bottles, plastic containers, wooden pallets and other wood, electronic waste, scrap metal (light and heavy) to include welding rods, white goods (appliances). FLUORESCENT LIGHT TUBES AND LEDs: All fluorescent light tubes and LEDs are to be turned in as hazardous waste. Call "You Call - We Haul", (315) 772-6111 to coordinate turn in.
