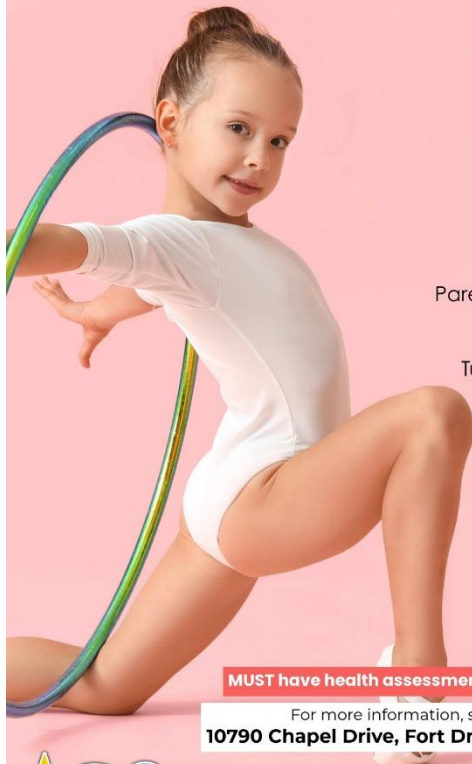

School District Calander for June

- Check parent square messages for updates on half days and last day of school.

Newly Arrived / Arriving Families

- Advanced enrollment.
- Contact your SLO for district zoning and registration information.
- High School students eligible for DOWEA Virtual High School (2 course limit per year).
- Districts bus to parochial schools (15-mile radius).
- Home School Groups and NY Home School Laws, contact your SLO for information.
- Universal Free Pre-k, child must be 4 by 1 DEC; apply at your zoned school district.

PCS with School Aged children

- Your Fort Drum SLO can connect you with the SLO at your new duty station.
- Disenroll your children from your current NY school.
- Unofficial copy of school records request.
- Hand carry documents.

SLO: Reminders

Transitioning Facts to Remember:

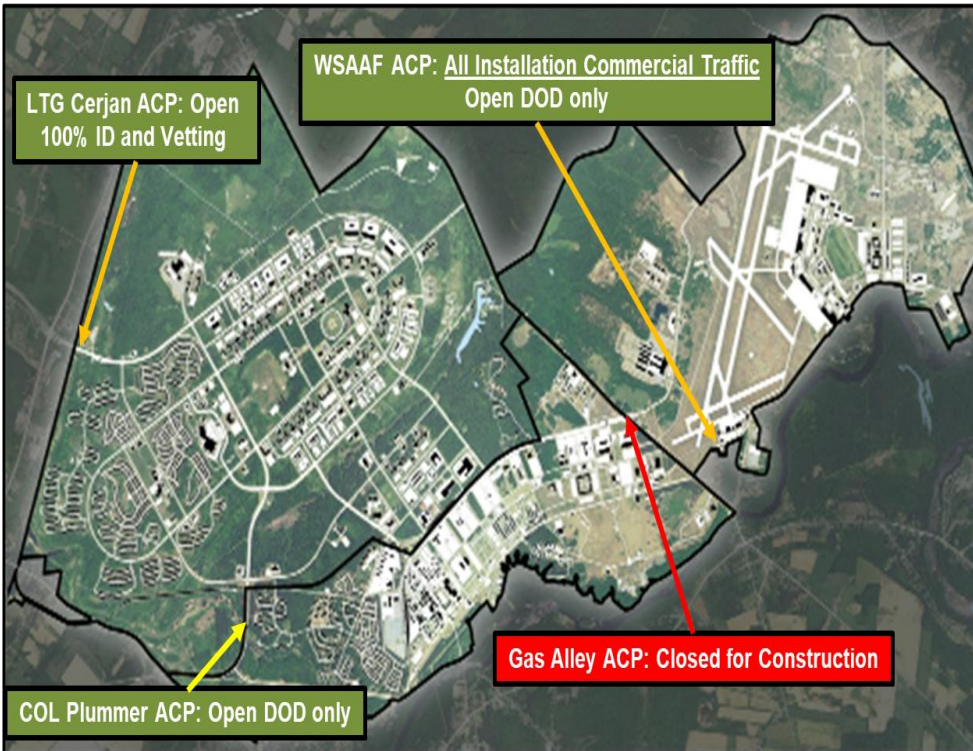
- State laws and educational programs vary; receiving SLO can clarify.
- Homeschool laws vary state to state.
- Interstate Compact for military children is law in all states.
- Kinder registration age requirements vary; the Interstate Compact may apply.
- Notify Principal/ teacher if moving prior to end of the School Year (SY).
- If unable to obtain complete grade report, work with teacher to complete curriculum; important if receiving district will be closed for the SY.
- Hand carry school registration documents; unofficial copy of school records.
- Include up to date IEP and 504 Plan.
- Fort Drum SLO can connect you with new duty station SLO.
- SLO can provide School PCS checklist and Youth Sponsor request.
- Families are encouraged to obtain school physicals prior to arrival.
- NY Schools will accept physicals from commissioned medical officers serving in the United States Armed Forces

Gas Alley ACP will close for construction on Friday and WSAAF ACP will open over the same weekend. (Guards will transition)

During construction phase until completion:

Access to the installation during construction:

All commercial traffic enters thru WSAAF ACP and utilizes Bomporto Bridge.

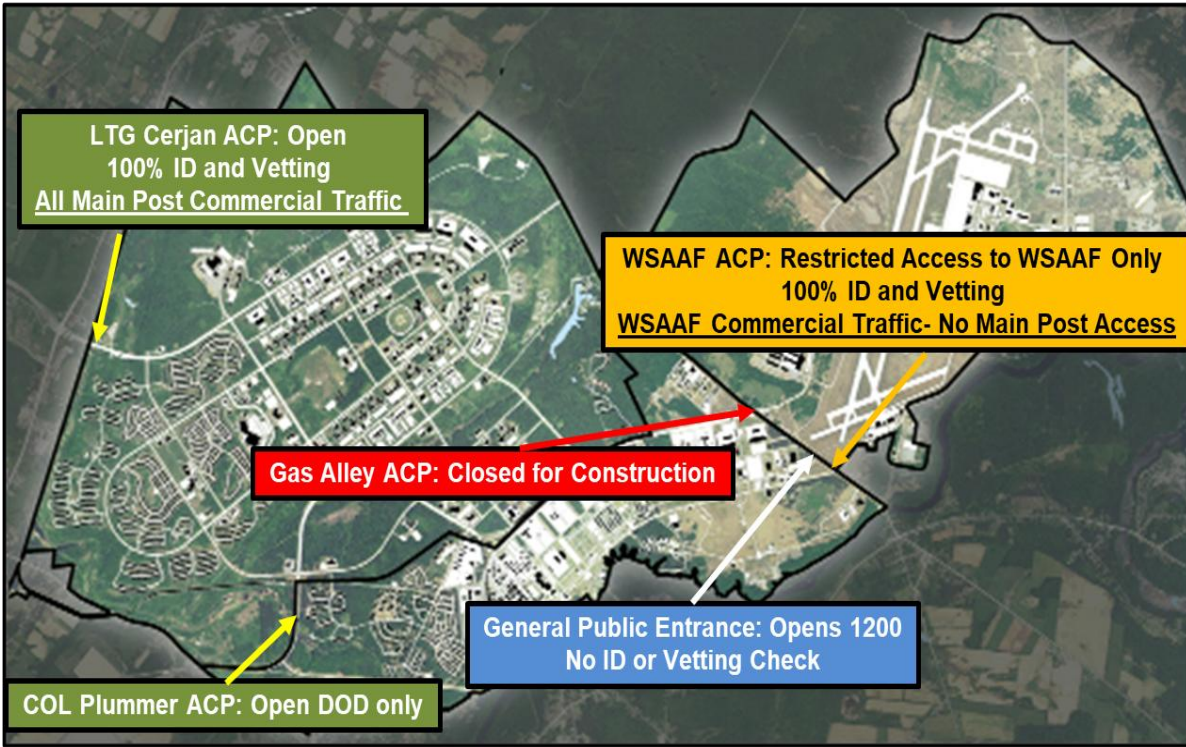
All visitors requiring access must first visit the Visitor Control Center to obtain a pass or badge. Local Access Badges (LAB) are authorized based on access frequency.

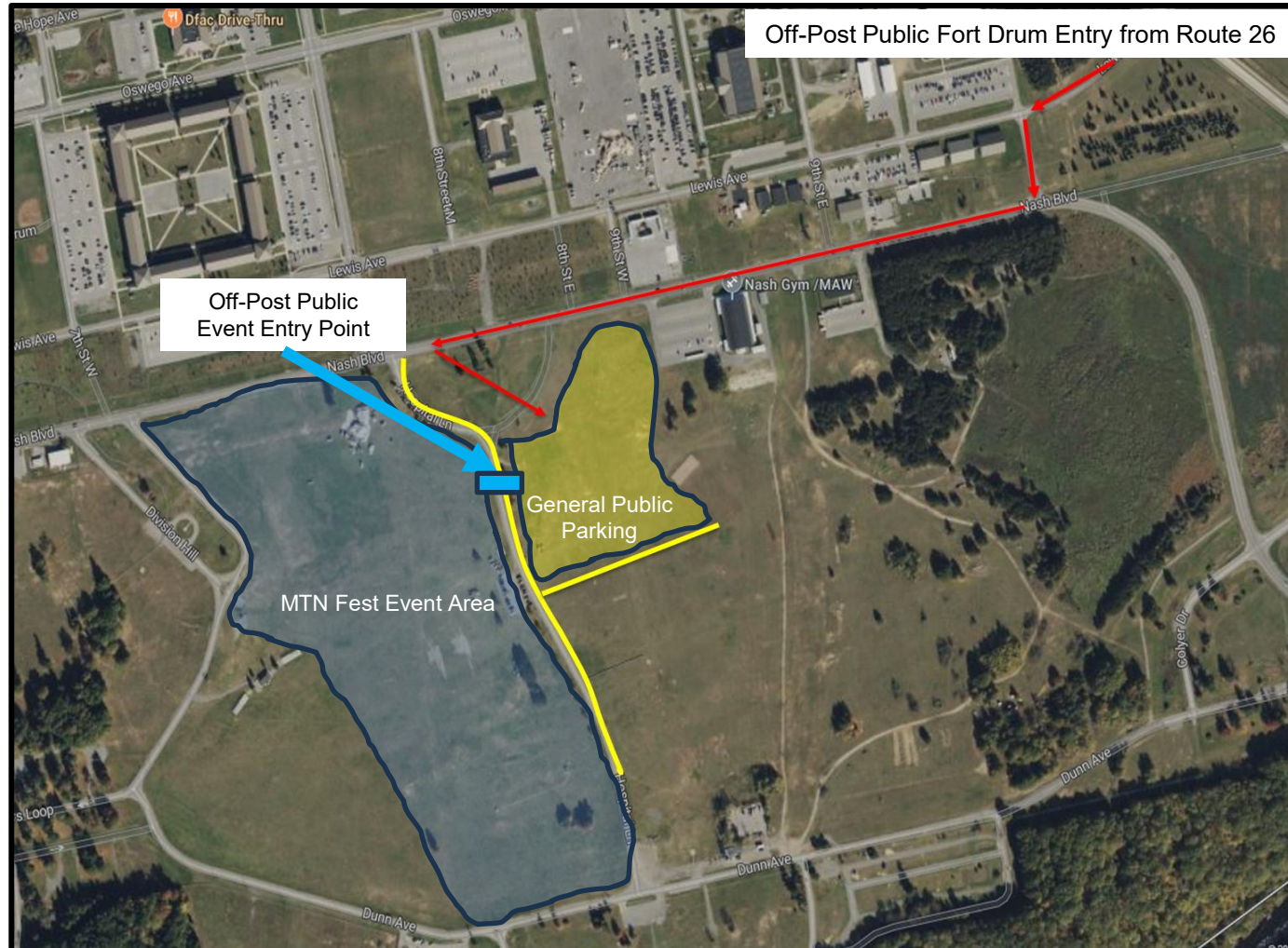

ACP Vetting: Mountainfest 2026

Acceptable Documents for Real Identification

Compliance with the REAL ID Act of 2005 effective 07MAY2025

Star, Flag or Not for Federal Purposes on the ID Visitors requesting access with no REAL ID or compliant supplementary form of identification must be sponsored and always escorted while on the installation. Personnel requiring escort will not be authorized Local Access Badge (LAB) credentials



Approved supplemental documentations:

- U.S. Passport or Passport Card
- Permanent resident card or Alien Registration Receipt Card (INS Form I-551).
- Foreign passport with temporary I-551 stamp or temporary I-551 printed notation on a machine-readable immigrant visa.
- Employment authorization document that contains a photograph (INS Form I-766).
- U.S. Military or Draft Record containing name and DOB.
- U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Card.
- Transportation Worker ID Card (TWIC) issued by DHS.
- Native American tribal document.
- Employee Identification Card issued by a federal, state or local government agency provided it contains a photograph and biometric information such as: Name, DOB, Gender, Height, Eye Color and/or Address.
- U.S. Government issued, authenticated Federal PIV credentials.
- VA Issued Health Card.
- *University, library, or school cards that contain a photo, name, and expiration date.*
- *Non-Government photo ID with a person's name and address*
- *Birth Certificate or document showing the person's full name and date of birth*
- *Current Utility bill or other documentation showing a person's name and address of principal residence.*
- *Vehicle registration with name and address.*

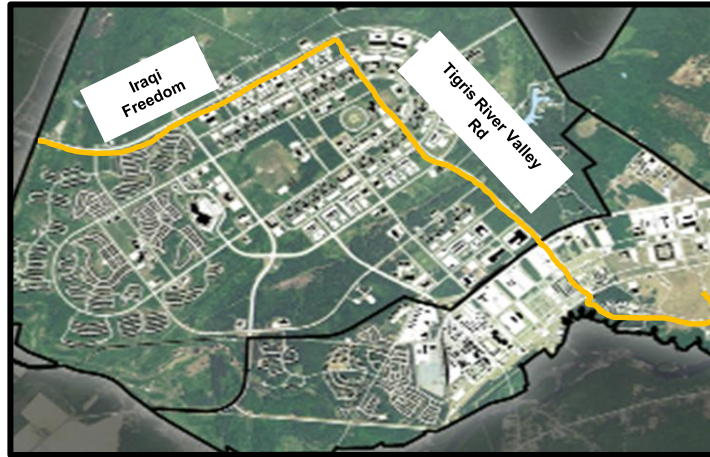

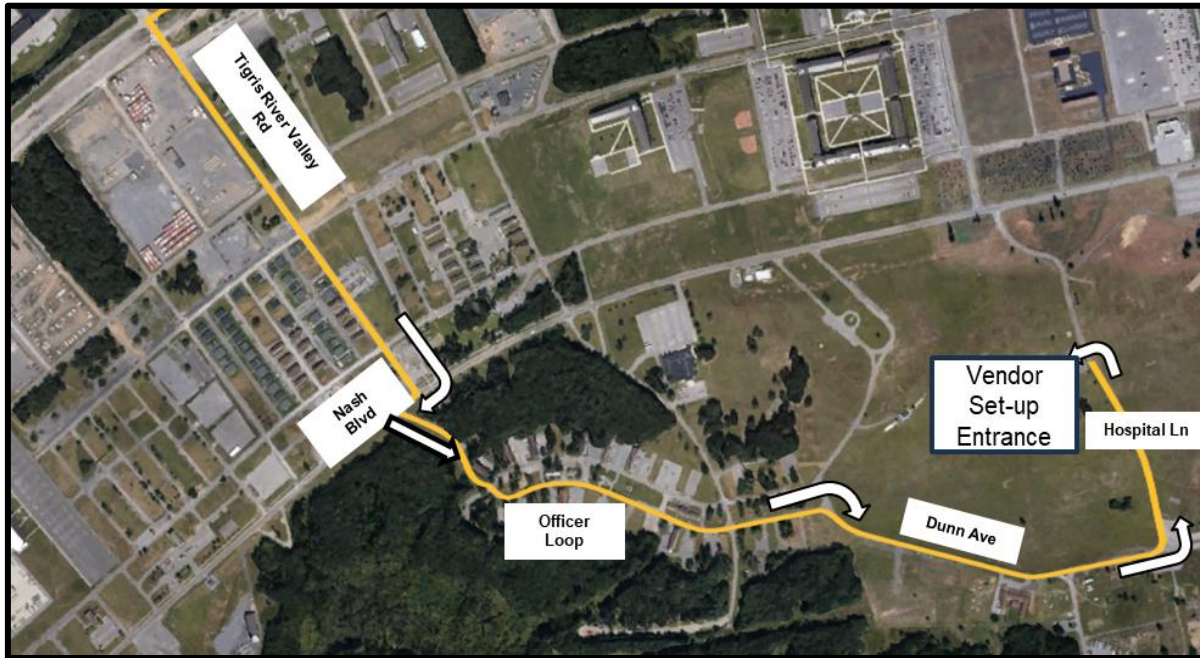

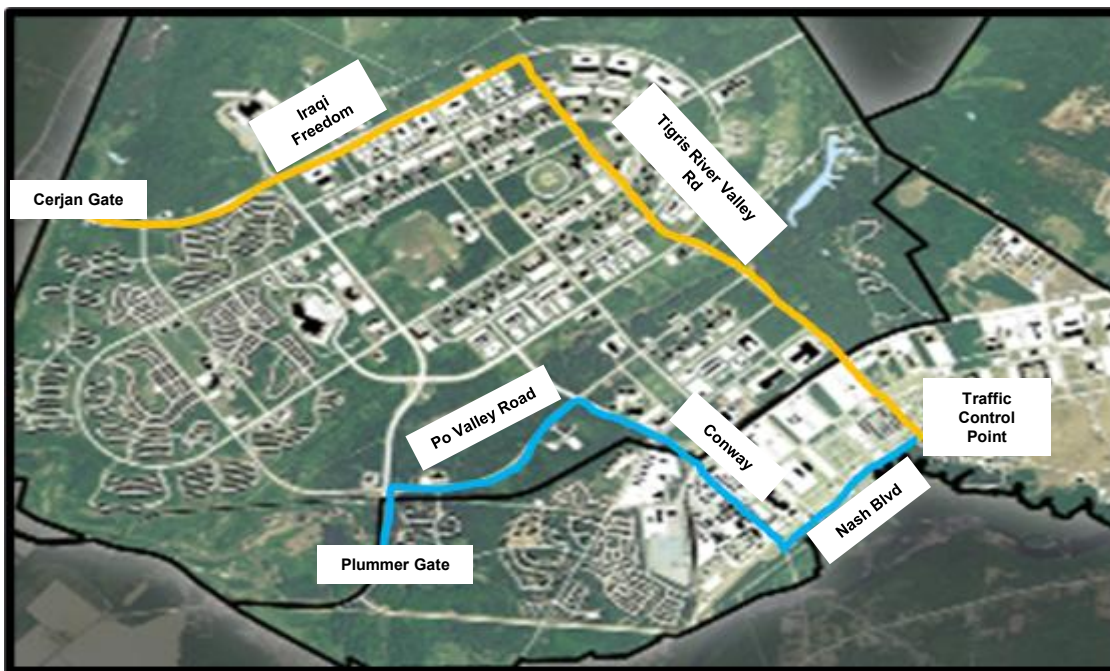

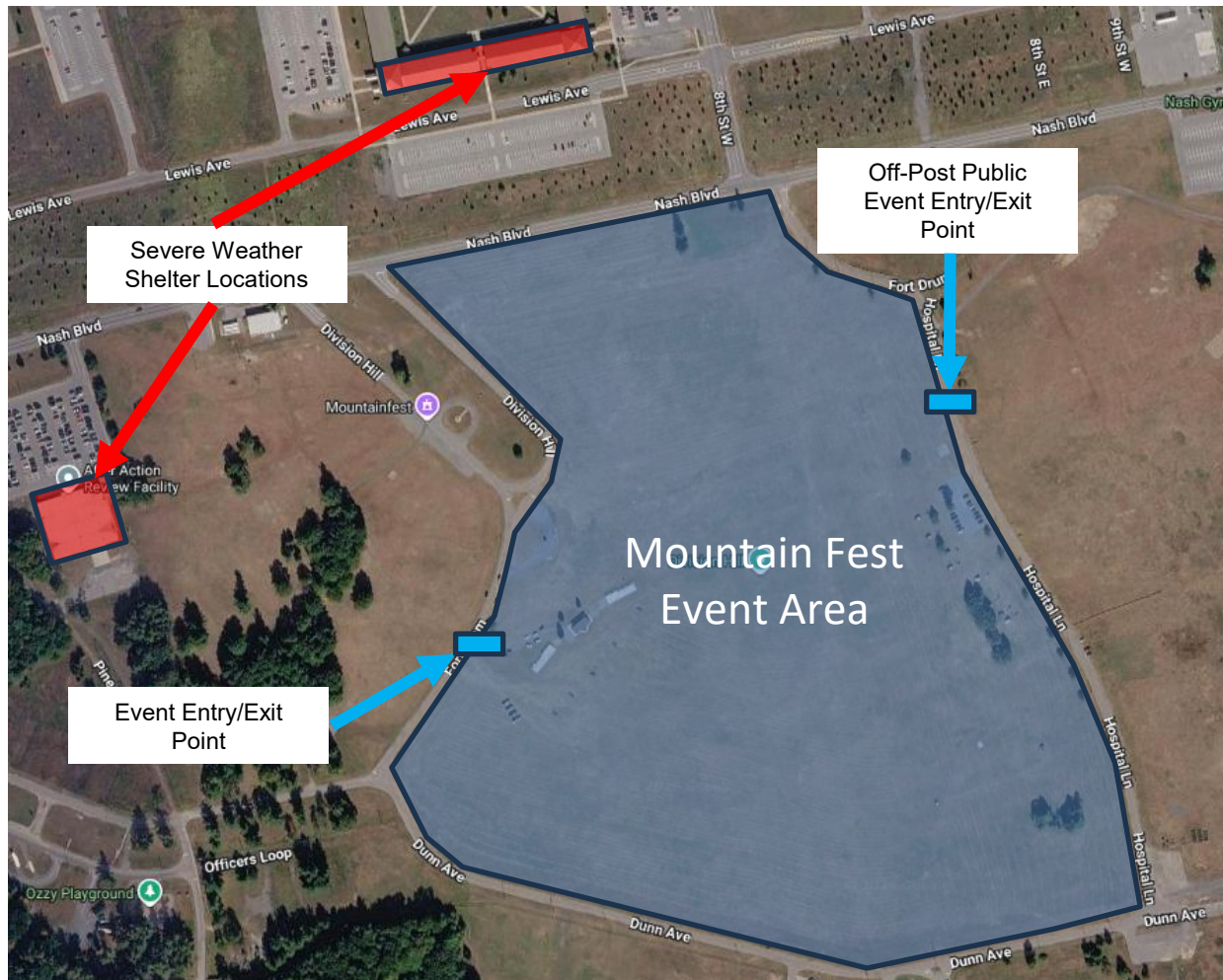

NEW RESIDENTIAL ROUTE!

What does this mean??



This new route will significantly decrease the run times to the Main Post route and will add Guthrie Clinic, Clark Hall and CSDV stops to the South Post route.

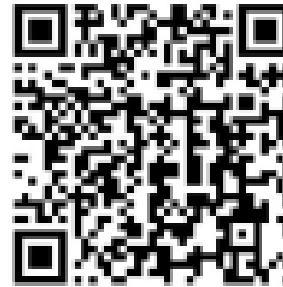
